Media Release

On January 20, 2023, at approximately 7:52 am patrol officers responded to the 700 block of North 16th Street on a report of a subject attempting to break into a residence. As officers arrived, the subject made entry into the residence. With the assistance of officers on scene, the occupants were able to get out of the residence unharmed and reported to officers the subject had a knife and was bleeding.

The subject was identified as Ryan Hahn age 35 had barricaded himself in the residence. Richmond S.W.A.T. was called to the scene to assist. Mr. Hahn was talking to officers but would not come out as requested. S.W.A.T. used less-lethal techniques to take Mr. Hahn safely into custody.

Mr. Hahn was transported to Reid Health by the Richmond Fire Department for treatment and ultimately admitted. Mr. Hahn was not admitted to Reid Health due to any injury sustained during the almost 2 ½ hour-long standoff with police.

This is an active open investigation at this time as Richmond Police Investigators are also involved in talking with witnesses and processing the scene.

Wayne County Sheriff's Department, Wayne County Emergency Communications and Richmond Fire/Rescue assisted the Richmond Police Department.
